Criw Cymraeg

Criw Cymraeg is made up of one pupil from every class in our school. We meet on a fortnightly basis to discuss what we have been working on, the progress we are making and our future plans. We set a 'phrase of the fortnight' on a fortnightly basis and this phrase is promoted around the school by staff and Criw Cymraeg members. Over the past year, we have worked hard on promoting the use of Welsh around the school and have introduced the 'Tocyn laith' and 'Siaradwr Yr Wythnos' reward schemes to help with this. Pupils can earn 'tokens' by speaking Welsh around the school. The 'Siaradwr Yr Wythnos' award is a weekly award given to the 'Welsh speaker of the week' in each class. These schemes aim to encourage and reward pupils for using Welsh inside and outside of their classroom. We also ran a 'Croeso' poster competition earler in the year and the winners of this competition are displayed in each classroom. Most recently, we decided on a set of Welsh yard games that would be run by the Criw Crymraeg for pupils in our school. This was set up with the aim of promoting Welsh outside of the classroom in a fun and engaging way for all pupils. This year we would like to get the Welsh yard games running on a daily basis and to continue working on embedding Welsh into our school ethos. We love working co-operatively to continuously improve the use of Welsh in our school.
