Year 3 Reading Books – Accessing Online Bug Club Reading Books



Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know, one of the most important things you can do to support your child's learning is to encourage them to read regularly at home. Whilst we will not be sending home physical reading books in the current COVID-19 situation, please rest assured that your child is reading regularly in school as part of their work throughout the curriculum and will also read Project X and class library books. This week, your child will has been allocated 'Bug Club' reading books which they can access online at home by following these steps:

## **How to Login:**

1. Go to the school website **www.llangewydd.co.uk** and click on the **'Curriculum'** menu. Select **'Useful Links'** from the drop-down menu and then click on the **'Bug Club'** logo.

Alternatively you may like to log on via the Active Learn website: www.activelearnprimary.co.uk

2. Your child has been given their own Bug Club password and username (see the Password bookmark that they have brought home) that follows the pattern below:

A child named *Harry Potter* would have the following (case sensitive) login details:

username: HarryP password: Potter school code: Ilju

3. You will now see your child's 'Homepage'

Your child will see their eBooks in 'My Stuff'. Simply click on a book's cover and begin reading. You can navigate through the pages using the arrows. You can also 'zoom in' on features as well as see a single or double page









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spread. Remember to answer all the quiz questions by clicking on the 'bug' icon.

4. Full details about how to use 'Bug Club' are included in the 'Parent Brochure – Bug Club Reading' that accompanies this letter.

'Bug Club' books have been allocated to your child following baseline reading assessments that we have undertaken at school. Please don't worry if you feel that your child's reading books are initially 'easy' for them to read as, following COVID-19 school closures during lockdown, we are focusing on building up your child's confidence in reading before moving on to more challenging texts.

The more your child reads at home, the better. We would encourage you to support your child in reading a wide range of texts including books you may already have at home, adverts, leaflets, timetables, menus, website texts, factual information, information books, instructions.....The list goes on.

On a different note, whilst the children's 'Big Maths' passwords are included on their password bookmarks, <u>please do not access Big Maths at home</u> as the children complete these assessments independently in school.
