
Your child will see their eBooks in 'My Stuff'.



Simply click on a book's cover and begin reading. You can navigate through the pages using the and arrows. You can also 'zoom in' on features as well as see a single or double page spread. Remember to answer all the quiz questions by clicking on the icon.

You do not have to answer all the questions in one reading session. You can come back to any of the books as many times as you like. Books you have finished reading will appear in your '**Library**'.

Rewards

When your child has finished reading a book and has answered the quiz questions, he or she will earn some golden coins

that they can save up or use to play games, race a scooter, collect stickers or buy items for a treehouse in one of the '*Bug Club*' reward worlds.

The Importance of Listening to Your Child Read

Research has shown that parental engagement with their child's reading has a more significant impact upon attainment than almost everything else. Now, more than ever before, it is so important to make time to share books with our children and to talk about what we read together.

Establish a regular time and place for reading. Encourage the children to talk about what they read – the themes, settings, characters, features of the text and the use of language.

Expose your child to a variety of reading materials – picture books, short stories, magazines, leaflets, letters, advertisements, atlases, encyclopaedias.....

Share your love of books and be 'caught' reading for pleasure. Let your child see you as a positive role model for reading and help them to understand how reading is an everyday life skill.

Why are we using eBooks?

Your child can enjoy reading books on screen and completing fun quiz questions found in the eBooks.



The questions will help your child practise important reading skills. Click on the 'Bug' icons throughout the eBooks to answer the questions. Once your child has answered the questions, the bug's eyes will close.

Some of the eBooks have a '*Read to me*' button so that the children can listen to an expressive reading of the text by professional storytellers and actors.

If you have access to the internet at home, your child can log on whenever they want to on iPads, tablets, laptops, *Kindle Fires*.....

If you don't have internet access at home, <u>your child will **not** miss out</u>. We will be making iPads and computers regularly available for the children to access the eBooks at school.
