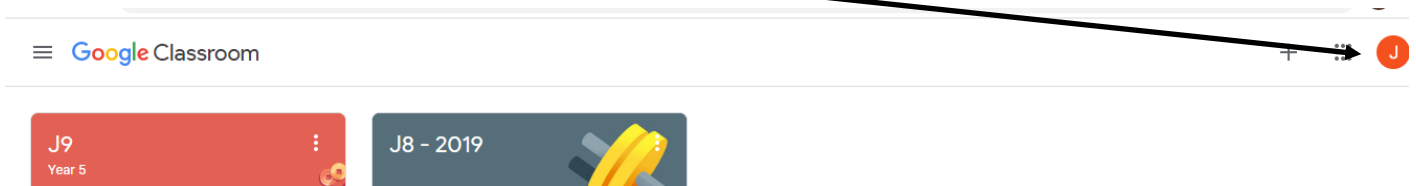


Troubleshooting

Can't see your classroom?

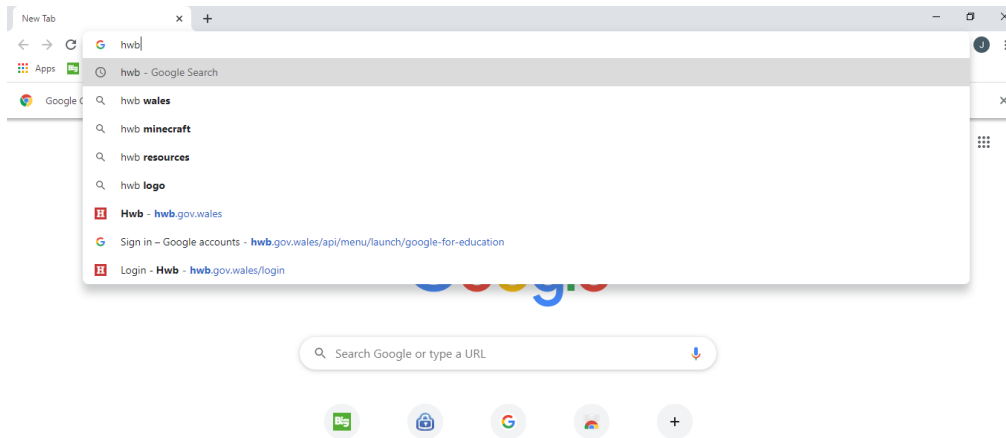
- If a parent has a Gmail account, when you sign into Hwb and then Google for Education, it will not automatically sign you out from the previous account. Please sign out and then place your Hwb username again to login.
- To check it is you logged in, look at the circle in the top right hand corner, hover over it and it will show which user is currently on Google. From here you can sign out and into your own account.



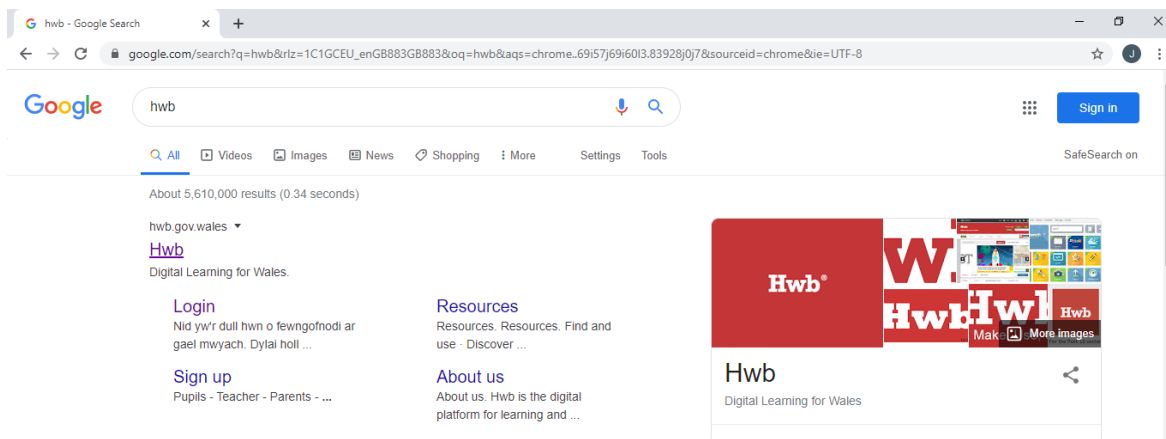
Trouble signing in?

- Usernames and passwords
- Sometimes o for orange and 0 the number get mixed up. Be careful. If one doesn't work, try the other.
- If you try your username/password a few times and it doesn't work the system will lock you out of your account. Try again in about 10 minutes.
- If problems still exist your password might need to be changed. Please let your teacher know.

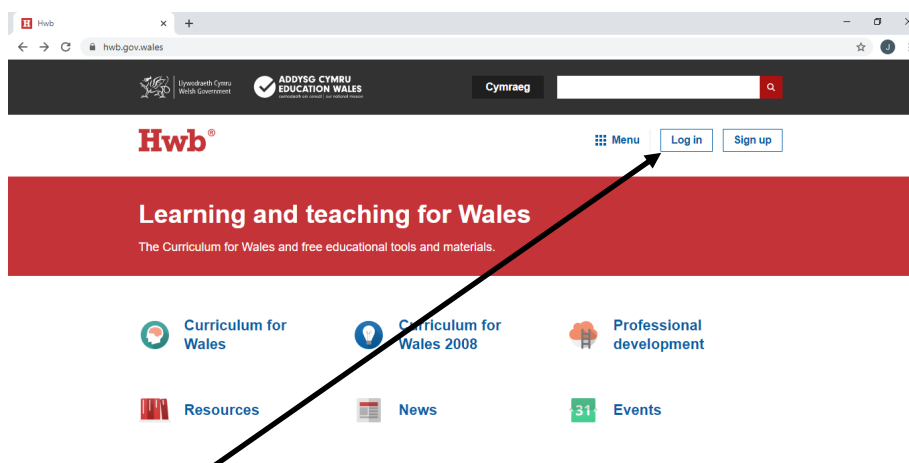
Google Classroom Guide

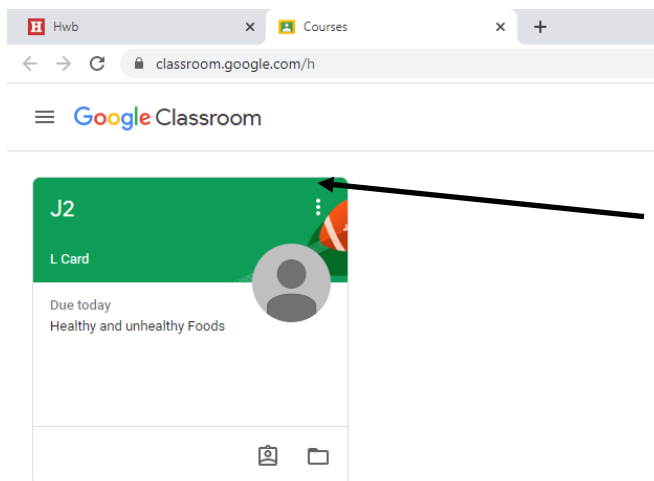

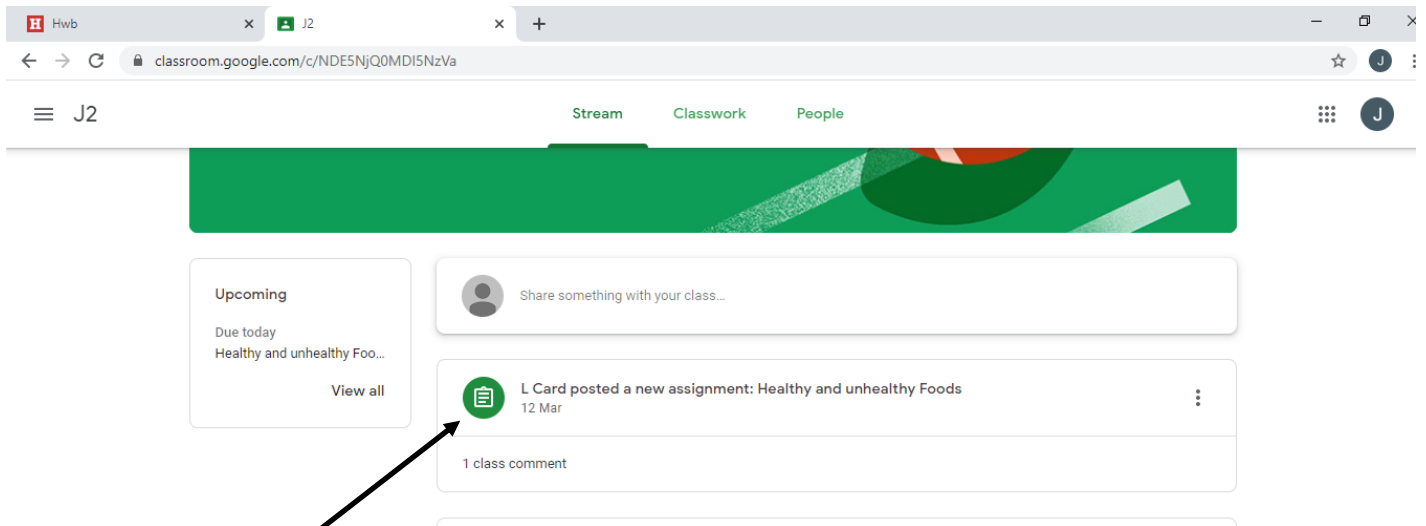
Click Google for Education

Here the teacher may have set homework, a quiz or asked a question. Children can respond to their teacher.

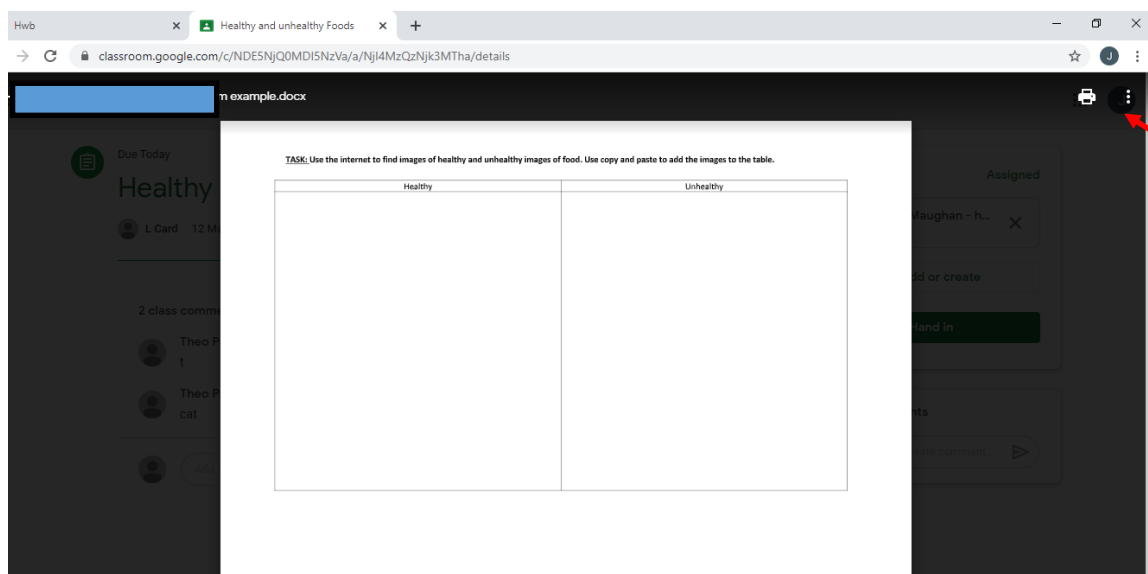

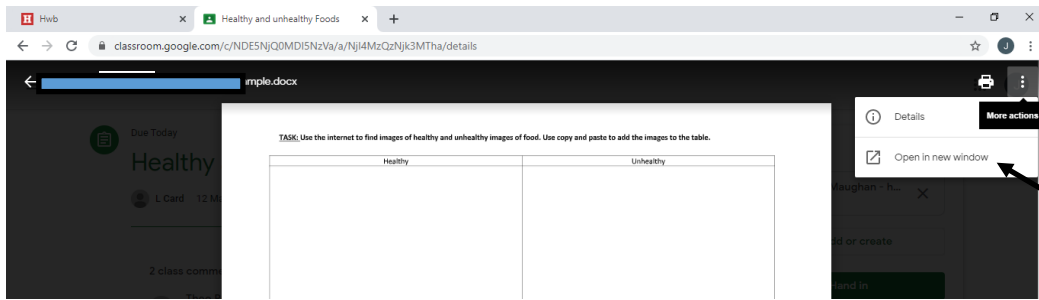
Homework tasks and assignments can be set through Google Classroom for children to complete. Click on the homework.



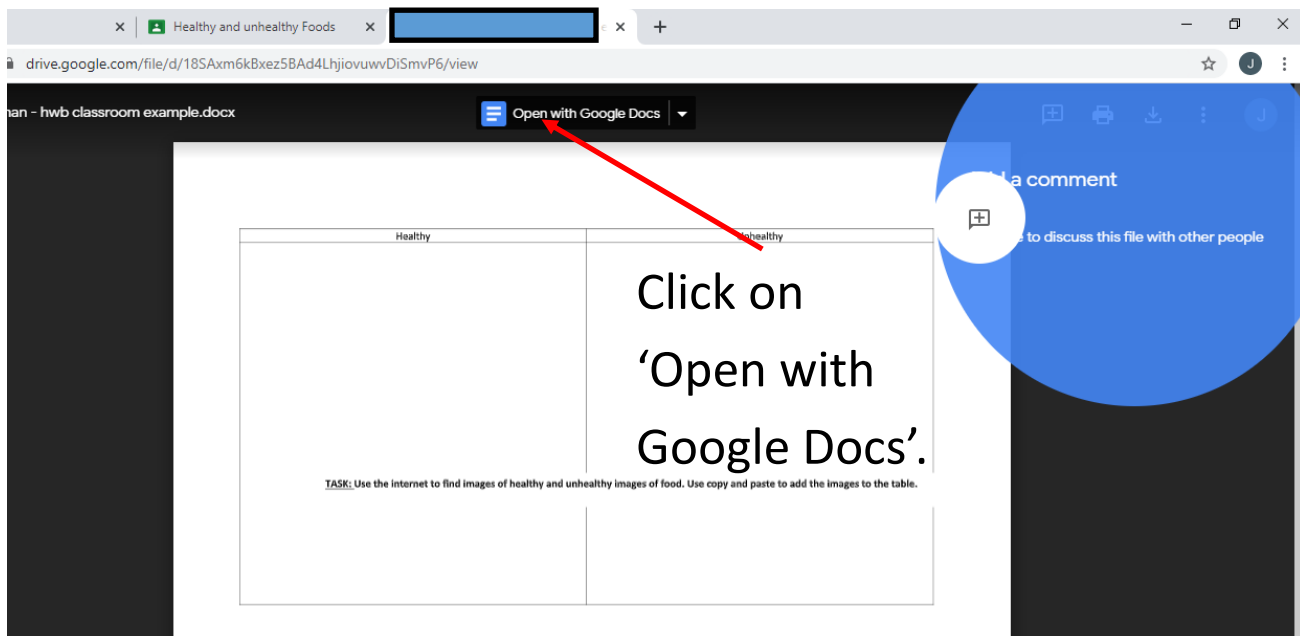
Click on the homework



Click on the 3 dots

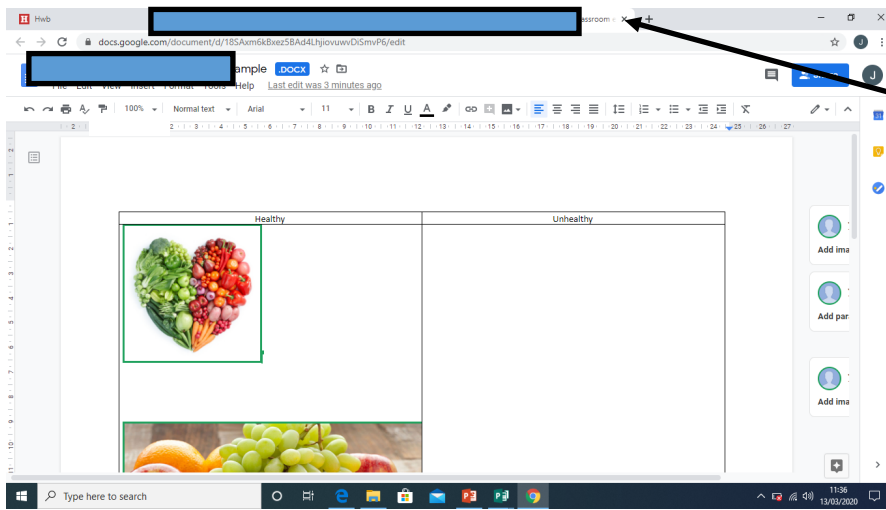


Click on

window'.

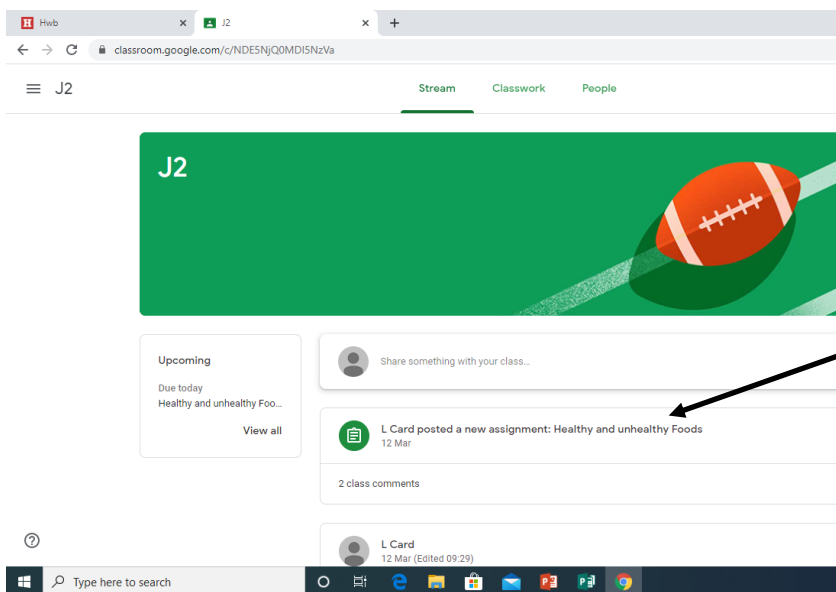


Click on

Google Docs'.

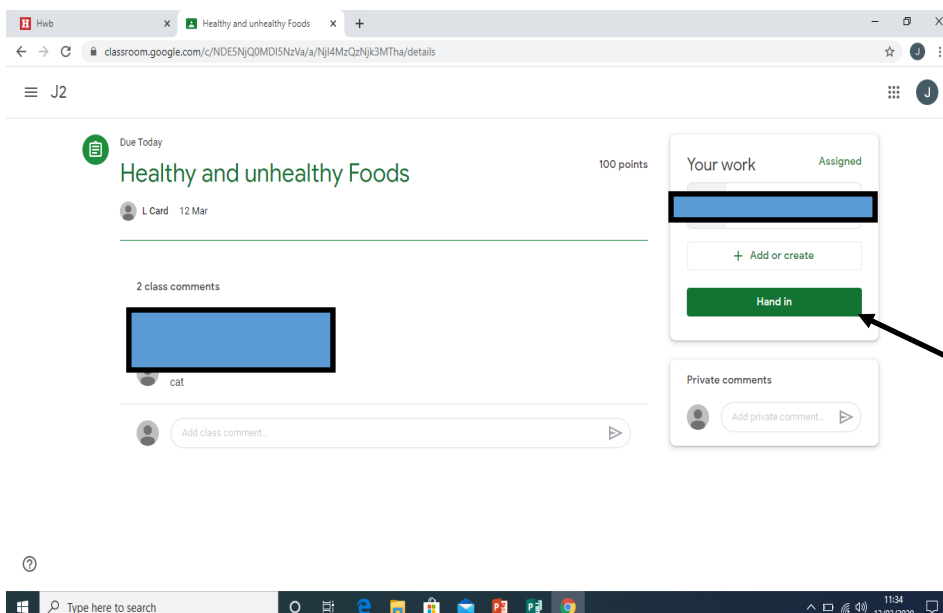
Now the children can work on their piece of work online!

click 'Save' or to worry if the computer shuts down.



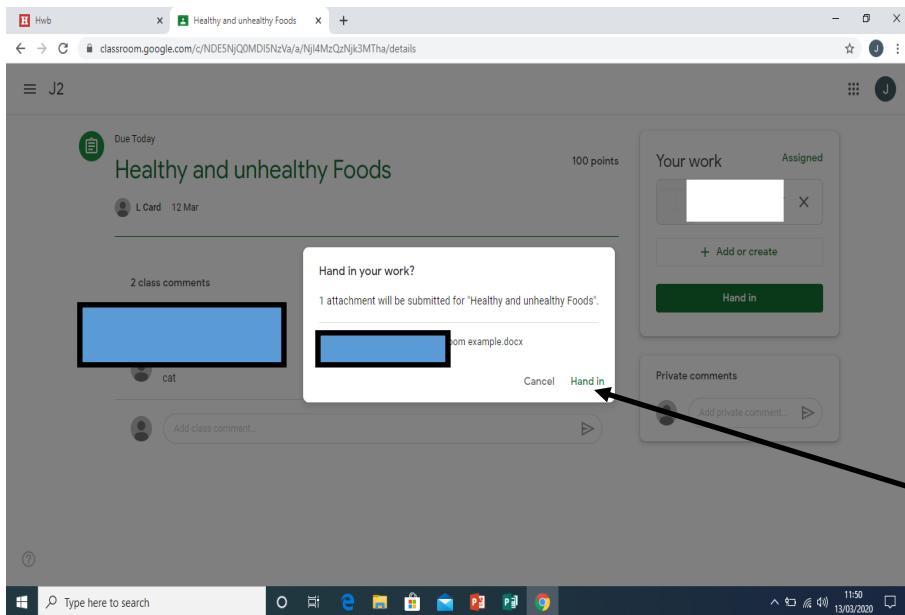
When you have finished your work, click the X to close the document.



Go back and click on the class assignment.

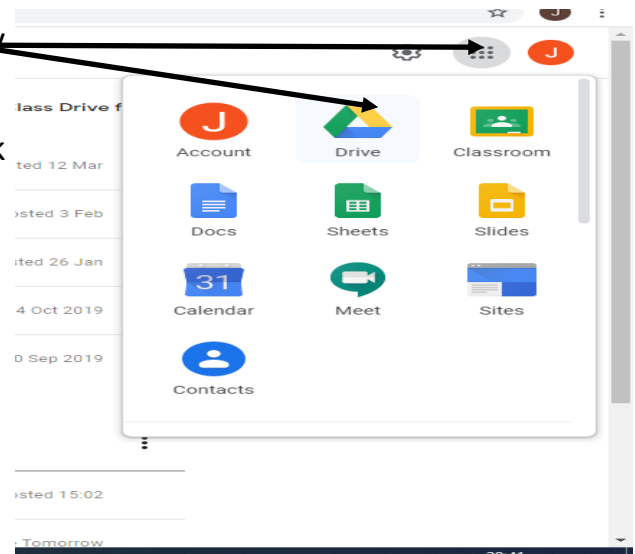


The final step is to click 'Hand in'.

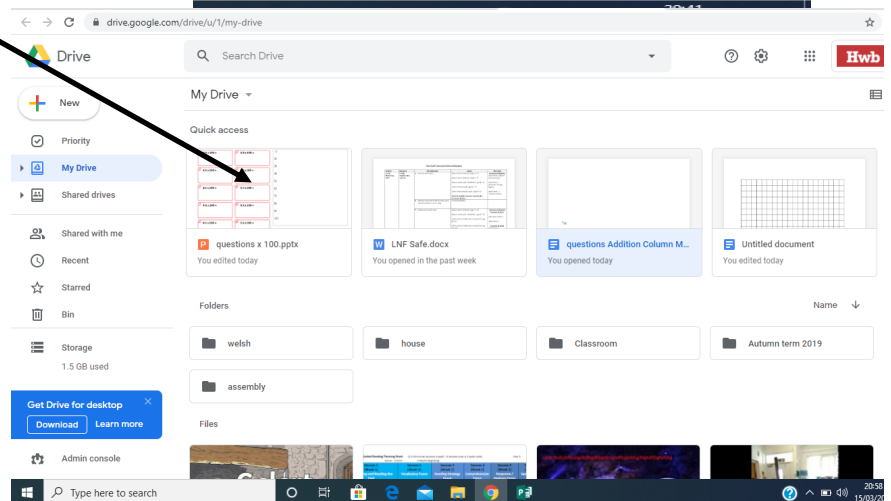


Click 'Hand in'. Now your teacher can see your completed piece of work.

Everything that you do will be automatically saved in your Google Drive. If you don't finish your assignment and need to go back at a later date you can edit it from here.



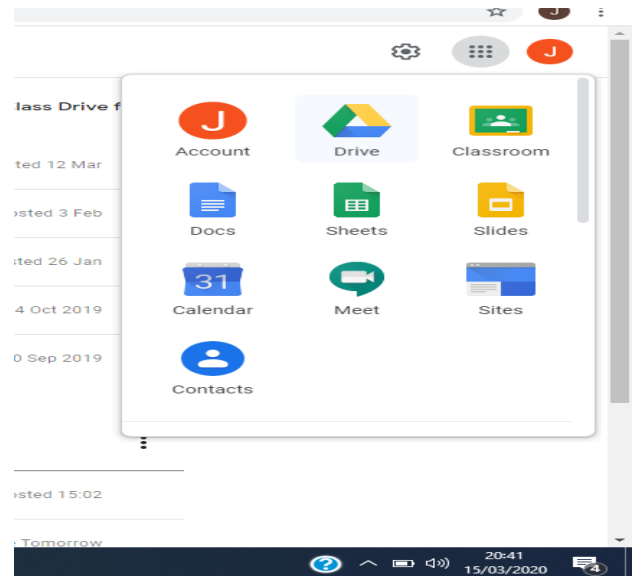
Your work will show in your drive.
