Year 7 secondary school admissions - September 2021

Due to the current pandemic, the local authority is unable to provide hardcopy letters to distribute to parents/carers. Therefore, all primary schools have been informed they **must** notify the parents/carers of all Year 6 pupils that they are required to submit an admission application for a Year 7 place at secondary school in September 2021 for their child/ren.

For children born between 1 September 2010 and 31 August 2011, transferring from junior/primary school (Year 6) to secondary school (Year 7) in September 2021, the timing of the admission round is as follows:

Action	Date
Opening date for submission of applications	10:00 hours,
	Monday, 19 October 2020
Closing date for receipt of applications by the local authority	16:00 hours, Friday, 22 January 2021

An application for a Year 7 place **must be submitted.** There is no automatic admission to any secondary school, regardless of the primary or junior school that a child currently attends.
