Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you so much for your support this week. We have been able to welcome our children back after the Easter break with more optimism than we have for such a long time. We do recognise that we are not 'out of the woods' yet but our clear protocols at both an individual and school level continue to serve us well.

Breakfast Club Arrangements

We will be resuming our Breakfast Club provision from Tuesday 4th May. This is the day after the May Day bank holiday and for that week we will be inviting year 6 and year 5 pupils to attend only (for clarity this **excludes siblings** in years 3 and 4). From Monday 11th May all pupils will be invited to attend.

All pupils attending will need to access the school from the main Heol Y Frenhines entrance only (the one used by years 3 and 5). We will open the Heol Y Frenhines gate for a period of **ten minutes only** at 8.20am and the gate will be shut at 8.30am. Pupils who arrive at school after 8.30am will have to wait for school to open 'as normal'. Pupils who attend will form year group 'bubbles' for the duration until the start of the school day. Initially all pupils will be seated at tables prior to lining up to be served in year groups. This does mean that all attendees will be in two bubbles, being the year group Breakfast Club bubble and their class bubble. All attendees at Breakfast Club must behave impeccably and follow all reasonable instructions from supervising adults at all times. Poor behaviour will result in this provision being withdrawn from individual pupils. Breakfast Club will finish at the start of the normal school day.

All parents and carers who wish their child to attend must complete a permission slip (below) which must be returned to their class teacher no later than Friday 23rd April.
