RE: Transition Session

As part of your child's transition from primary to secondary school, we are pleased to invite your son/daughter to a transition session at Bryntirion Comprehensive School on Wednesday, 23rd June 2021 at 9.15am. Current Covid guidelines allow the primary school pupils to visit us, but during their time at Bryntirion the pupils will need to follow our secondary school protocols. The visit will not be as long as our normal transition days as we need to ensure the primary school pupils do not mix or come into contact with our own pupils. The visit will be for just under two hours and will involve orientation activities, a tour of the school and a sample lesson. Pupils will remain in their school bubbles for the entirety of the visit.

Pupils will attend their primary school as normal on this day and will walk to Bryntirion accompanied by primary school staff. Attendance at the transition event is not compulsory but we hope your child will welcome the opportunity to get a little flavour of life at Bryntirion; we are doing our utmost to ensure the children are welcomed and supported in a safe and Covid compliant way.

Please let your child's Year 6 tutor know if your child will **NOT** be attending the transition event, as they will need to make alternative arrangements for your child whilst the other pupils visit Bryntirion. We look forward to meeting your child soon and welcoming them to Bryntirion.
