I am going to be running an after school cookery club for the children in Year 6 starting Tuesday 11th January for 6 weeks. The sessions include learning about food hygiene, preparing and cooking food and keeping the kitchen clean and tidy. The sessions start straight after school and finish at 4:45pm. **Due to the late finish time, all children must be collected from the lower hall where the club takes place – no child will be allowed to walk home unaccompanied.**

Due to the cost of ingredients I ask for a contribution of £6 (£1 per week), payable at the start of the first session.

I may need to split the group into two cohorts of 10 each, with one cohort attending in January and the next cohort after February half term. Places will be awarded a first come first served basis.
