Your child's first performance is on the Tuesday at 5.30pm. Your child must be brought to school through the Heoly-Frenhines entrance between 5pm and 5.10pm. Please do not arrive before this time. Pupils will change in the classes in which they are taught and parents may make their way directly to our top hall once their child has been deposited. The school will not open before 5pm so please do not arrive before this time.

Once the year 3 performance has finished:

- pupils will be taken back to class where they will leave their outfits for the following morning's performance. Once pupils have left the hall you will be ushered onto the 'top yard' outside the year 3 classrooms. We will then hand over your child from one of the two exits of the buildings onto the top
- if you also have a child in year 5 and you have a valid ticket you may remain in the hall for the following (year 5) performance and your child will be brought to you where they may sit on your lap but not occupy
- you may leave the school through any exit.

Your child's second performance is on Wednesday morning at 9.30. Pupils should come to school as normal. At 9.15am I will open the gate at the Heol-Y-Frenhines entrance, this will be the only entrance that parents can use. Should parents present themselves at the Llangewydd Road entrance they will be redirected out of the school to enter through the Heol-Frenhines entrance. At the end of this performance parents will exit the school through the same Heol -Y- Frenhines exit.

As a pre-cursor to the concerts the following day, on Monday 12th December we will be having our dress rehearsals where our year 4 pupils will watch the year 6 pupils perform (and vice versa) and our year 3 pupils will watch our year 5 pupils perform (and again vice versa). This rehearsal is not for parents.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO CHILD WILL BE ALLOWED TO WALK HOME UNACCOMPANIED FROM CONCERTS HELD IN THE EVENING AND WE DO PLEAD THAT EVERY EFFORT IS MADE TO BRING PUPILS TO THE EVENING PERFORMANCE FOR THE SAKE OF ALL PARTICIPANTS.
