Our approach

Who/What?

This is a toolkit to help schools explain to parents and carers about the help with school costs that might be available to them - including School Essentials (PDG Access) and the rollout of Universal Primary Free School Meals (UPFSM).

Why?

Across Wales, up to 40% of parents are not claiming the help with school costs they are entitled to. In recognition of the rising cost of living, we are urging parents and carers to claim the support they might be entitled to, to help pay for school essentials.

Based on our findings from focus groups across Wales, we have found that parents expect to hear directly from their schools and Local Authorities about changes to their child's education.

Why now?

Parents and carers need to know what's changing and what that will mean for their child.

In September 2022, the rollout of Universal Primary Free School Meals across Wales will begin, starting with learners in Reception. The policy is part of the Co-operation Agreement between the Welsh Government and Plaid Cymru, which will see free school meals extended to all primary school learners over the next two years.

How?

Together, we can ensure that parents and carers have the right information about what support is on offer, as well as how and where to apply. In this toolkit, you'll find everything you need to share information with parents and carers of learners at your school.

Playing your part

You can help us raise awareness among parents and carers at your school or setting.

We have created a bank of ready-made assets that you can use on your school's or setting's communication channels, be that social media, school apps, emails, posters around the building, or banners on the school gates.

What you can do:

- Share posts on your social media channels
- Print out posters and display them around areas parents and carers visit
- Write about the School Essentials (PDG Access) and the rollout of Universal Primary Free School Meals (UPFSM) in your newsletter, or use the templates provided
- Send messages to parents and carers via email, WhatsApp or any other communication channels used
- Host a 'What you need to know about financial support for School Essentials (PDG Access)' session with parents and carers

Key phrases and messages



Key phrases for parents and carers

Here are the key phrases that must be considered throughout our writing.

UPFSM: Universal Primary Free School Meals

The rollout of Universal Primary
Free School Meals will begin with
Reception in September 2022,
and extend to Years 1 and 2
no later than the start of the
Summer term, April 2023.
The aim is for all primary school
children to receive a free lunch
in schools within two years.

eFSM: Existing Free School Meals

You might see the phrase eFSM alongside information about UPFSM. You need to apply for eligibility to receive free school meals regardless of the rollout of UPFSM – if eligible, you and your school will receive extra funding.

School Essentials (PDG Access)

The above refers to the support that might be available to those currently in receipt of, or eligible for, Free School Meals. School Essentials (PDG Access) can help pay for things like school uniform, footwear, stationery, sports kit and other equipment.

The allowance has been raised by £100 for this year only to £225 per learner, or £300 for those going into Year 7, to recognise the additional costs of starting secondary school.

Key messages for parents and carers

Here are some key messages that will help parents and carers understand more about the School Essentials (PDG Access), and the rollout of Universal Primary Free School Meals (UPFSM).

- In Wales, up to 40% of eligible parents are not claiming the financial support they are entitled to for help with school essentials.
- If your child is currently in receipt of Free School Meals, you may also be entitled to additional help for School Essentials (PDG Access).
- School Essentials (PDG Access) helps with school essentials such as uniform, footwear, sports kit, stationery, and other equipment.
- The Universal Free School Meals policy is part of the Co-operation Agreement between the Welsh Government and Plaid Cymru, which will see free school meals extended to all primary school learners over the next two years.
- From September 2022, every primary school in Wales will offer Free School Meals for all children in Reception.

- If your child is starting reception class in September, they will be offered the new, Universal Primary Free School Meals (UPFSM). However, if you are in receipt of a certain income, parents will still need to apply separately to the local authority for School Essentials (PDG Access) to access all of the funding available.
- If your child is older than Reception class, they
 may be eligible to receive Free School Meals
 and funding for school essentials. It is very
 important to your child's school that you apply.
 The school can access additional funding for
 children who qualify for Free School Meals
 (eFSM) that will allow them to provide targeted
 support programmes, buy equipment and
 provide extra resources.

Newsletter / email template

Dear Parent/Carer,

As the cost of living rises, no child should go without. In Wales, nearly half of parents are not claiming the free school meals that their children are entitled to. We are writing to remind you of the three types of support you might be entitled to.

Don't miss out on Free School Meals. School meals promote healthy eating, increase the variety of food your child might eat, and can improve behaviour and social skills. If you receive certain benefits, or your circumstances have changed, check if you're entitled through [INSERT LOCAL AUTHORITY URL].

If your child already gets free school meals, there could be more help available through School Essentials (PDG Access). This helps with the costs of school essentials like uniforms and equipment to make sure they are ready for the school day.
