Dear Parent/Guardian

We are delighted that you have chosen to educate your son/daughter at Bryntirion Comprehensive School from September 2023. It is a very exciting time to join us at Bryntirion and I'm sure you will enjoy being part of our school community.

We would like to share the following transition information:-

- **Year 6 Mini Olympics – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023 9.30pm - 12.00pm** – A morning session of sporting events so please could students wear PE kit and trainers and ensure they have water, sun cream and a hat. Students from Llangwydd, Maes Yr Haul, Penyfai and Trelales primary schools should attend their primary schools as normal on this day. Staff from the primary schools will accompany students to Bryntirion Comprehensive School at 9.15am and will leave Bryntirion at 12 noon. The parents of students from other primary schools are asked to bring their child to the school for 9.20am and collect at 12 noon.
- **Transition Day - Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023** - The aim of the day will be to give students a 'taste' of life at Bryntirion Comprehensive School before they join us in September. Students will have the opportunity to experience a range of lessons and spend time with other Year 6 students who will also be joining the school. They may bring sandwiches or buy lunch in the canteen. Lunch will cost around £2.50. Students may also buy a snack at break-time from the breakfast bar costing around £1. Students should make their own way to the school for 9.00am in their primary school uniform and go to the Sports Hall in E block where they will be met by Mrs Poole - Head of Year. We will have plenty of students and staff waiting eagerly to welcome and show students the way. Students will finish school at 2.45pm and should make your own arrangements for getting home (just as they will when they start in September). - **Year 6 Parents Meeting – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2023, 5.00pm** – It would be wonderful to meet you as parents and as such would like to invite you to a meeting for parents on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July at 5.00pm in our Sports Hall. This will provide you with an opportunity to meet some of the key staff and discuss the arrangements for September.
