Headteachers Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have been in school for four weeks now and the children seemed to have settled well into their new classes. We have a busy term ahead with lots of events, Parent Cafes and Family Learning Programmes on offer. A few reminders to ensure the school day runs smoothly:

- Ensure your child's clothing is labelled with their name. We already have lots of items left in school that nobody has claimed.
- For Safeguarding reasons parents/carers/visitors should not be entering the school building unless they go through the main door and are greeted by Miss Jury.
- Timings Year 4,5,6 start school at 8:50am and school ends at 3:25pm
 - Year 3 start at 9am however the gate opens at 8:55am. School ends at 3:30pm, parents/carers can collect from the vard if they wish.
 - The Heol y Frenhines gate will be locked promptly at 9:05am. Anybody arriving after this time will need to report to the main entrance.
- If your child is poorly and is not going to be in school, please inform Miss Jury early that morning. If we don't know where your child is, a phone call home will be made. If we fail to make contact there will be a home visit made the same day.

The first meeting was successful and I would personally like to thank those parents/carers that attended. The next meeting is on Tuesday 3rd October at 2:30pm in the Uniform Swap Shop.
