Urdd City Centre Sleepover 7th – 9th February 2024

We are pleased to again be running the Year 5 residential trip to the Urdd City Centre at Cardiff Bay. The 2-night stay ($7^{th} - 9^{th}$ February 2024) will include visits to many places of interest in and around the capital such as Big Pit, the Principality Stadium, National Assembly, a boat trip around the Bay and an evening bowling, to name a few.

The trip will offer your child opportunities to develop their personal and social skills, encourage teamwork and develop independence, as well as providing them with experiences to enhance their learning. The trip will cost parents/carers approximately £155. All transport costs will be paid for by the school. The £155 will include accommodation (sleeping bag required), all meals (apart from lunch on the first day) and any fees incurred at our venues.

Places are limited to 42 pupils. In the event that more children wish to attend than there are places, we will undertake a random draw to allocate places. We will collect the money in instalments and once the first instalment has been paid, you will have secured your child's place on the trip (subject to available places), but you will have also committed to pay the full £155 (as the school will have to pay this to the Urdd even if you decide at a later date to not attend). Please be clear that once you have paid the £40 instalment, you will be required to pay the balance of the £155 even if your child withdraws from the trip at a later date.

Should your child attend the trip, we would require the following:

- £50 deposit by Thursday 30th November
- £50 by Thursday 21st December
- The final instalment of £55 by Friday 26th January

Once interest is known, we will inform you about how we, as a cashless school, will manage the receipt of instalments. **We will not be able to receive cash.**
