Where is it? Urdd Centre, Cardiff Bay

When is it? 7th - 9th February 2024

What staff are going? 4 female members of staff and 2 male members of staff are going on the trip. These are: Miss Lewis, Mrs Porter, Mrs Card, Miss Jones, Mr Parker and Mr Dixon.

Sleeping arrangements: Pupils will sleep in rooms of up to 6 (there are rooms of 3/4/5 and 6). We will have finalised the sleeping arrangements by this Wednesday.

What do I need to provide?

Essential:

- Packed lunch for day 1 this MUST go in your child's rucksacks as their main bag/case will go in the hold storage on the bottom of the bus.
- Sleeping bag
- Pyjamas
- Toiletries body wash, shampoo
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Clothes enough for three days. At least one warm jumper required. Please ensure names are on clothing where possible.
- Underwear and socks
- Waterproof coat
- Suitable shoes for walking no heeled boots.
- Day rucksack to carry lunch and water bottle

Optional:

- 1 comfort toy for bed if needed (this will not be taken out on our daytime activities).
- Pen/pencils and a notebook or a reading book for downtime.

What not to bring?

Any electronic devices including phones

No money

No food, snacks or drinks. All main meals are being provided by the Urdd Centre and the school are going to provide extra snacks.

How will I know that everything is ok?

There'll be pictures on Twitter to follow. If needed, we will contact you. In an emergency, contact the school or the Urdd Centre (only to be contacted after school hours and in an absolute emergency).

My child has never slept away before, will they be ok?

Not a problem. Staff are always at hand to reassure pupils. Quite often pupils are shattered after a full day of visits!

Medication:

Any medication must be handed to Mrs Porter in a clear bag with your child's name and instructions on how to administer, on the morning of the trip. Where possible, the medication should come in the correctly labelled box.

You must ensure that all mediation is in date and that there is sufficient supply to last the entirety of the trip.

Allergies:

All allergies must be included in the health forms. The Urdd Centre chefs have been made aware of any allergies that have been included in the health forms to date and meals will be adjusted accordingly.

If any new allergies or medication starts between now and the trip, it is your responsibility to inform us. We will then make arrangements accordingly

Lunch orders:

Packed lunches are provided by the Urdd Centre for days two and three of the trip. This week the pupils will be asked to choose from the following lunch options: Ham, Cheese, Tuna, Vegetarian and Vegan.
