### Teaching and learning-

In our committee meetings we have been practicing the signs to our songs in assembly and we have recorded new videos introducing British Sign Language (BSL). We are looking forward to teaching the school songs with BSL actions. Mrs Card's & Year 6 pupil's videos introducing new signs each week are going to be introduced back into classes each week. We have also been encouraging and teaching other classes the meaning of silent solo, cold call and turn and talk.

### Criw Cymraeg-

We have been practising Welsh Yard games like 'Fish' to promote Welsh around the school and Welsh games in assembly like "guess the Welsh place!" or "guess the Welsh food!" So pupils don't just learn Welsh, they also get to have fun! Each Criw Cymraeg member has a Welsh badge to show that they are Criw Cymraeg members to teach Welsh around the school yard which promotes Welsh around the school.

#### Playground Leaders Committee-

In playground committee we have new equipment of our choice such as toss and catch, skipping ropes and so much more! We have also, as a school, been putting the yard equipment away and have got new buddy monitors on the yard for people who are alone and need someone to play with. They wear high vis vests so you can find them easily. The vests go around the whole school classes, so everybody gets a turn of being a monitor. We also took part in the big walk to school in March and the 2 winning classes got badges. Our gym equipment is being fitted soon! We are also looking into having a canopy to provide shelter and shade.

#### Digital Leaders-

We have a new teacher looking after digital leaders as Mrs Davies has left, our new leader is Mrs Fletcher. We have made online posters that will be up soon and to promote looking after the ICT equipment. We now have digital leaders to put chrome books and ipads away.

#### Rights committee-

In the rights committee we have made sure everyone knows the importance of our child/human rights. We have displayed these rights all around the school. We also have rights class assemblies on a Monday for the day/week these assemblies are held by the rights committee.
