Dear Parents/Carers

We are excited to inform you that the Year 6 pupils will be going on a residential trip to Parkwood Outdoor Centre Dolygaer on the outskirts of the Brecon Beacons from **Wednesday 8th July to Friday 10th July**. This trip promises to be a wonderful experience for the children, filled with opportunities for growth, learning and fun.

The total cost of the trip will be £198 per pupil. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals (not the Welsh Government Universal Free School Meals), the cost of the trip will be £150 per pupil. School is paying the cost of transport to and from the venue for all pupils attending as well as subsidising the cost of the venue. We understand that this may be a significant amount, so we are offering the option to pay in installments through School Money. The details of these installments are below for your reference.

#### Installments

**Thursday 23rd October** (non-refundable deposit to secure the place - £49.50 non-free school meal, £37.50 free school meal pupils)

**Friday 28th November** Payment 2 - £49.50 non-free school meal, £37.50 free school meal pupils

**Wednesday 17th December** Payment 3 - £49.50 non-free school meal, £37.50 free school meal pupils

**Friday 30th January** Payment 4 - £49.50 non-free school meal, £37.50 free school meal pupils
