Part/Role	Costume ideas/suggestions
All Narrators	Boys – Christmas jumper or smart party outfit e.g. smart trousers, shirt, tie / bow tie, waistcoat
Pupils 1 and 2	Girls – Christmas jumper or smart, sparkly party dress/outfit
Action Hero	Action/superhero outfit maybe with a homemade 'A' logo Buzz Lightyear style
Robot Man	A metallic robot outfit – maybe made out of cardboard boxes
Teddy	Teddy bear outfit.
Beauty Doll	Barbie-inspired, glamorous doll outfit, long blonde wig, accessories
Magic Mirror	a metallic, mirror-effect outfit with head through cardboard covered in foil
Referee	football referee kit – with red and yellow cards and a whistle
Mystery Gift	a large box beautifully wrapped with Christmas wrapping paper/tinsel with holes for the arms, legs and head.
iPad	so that the actor looks like a large-scale iPad

Blue team footballers	blue football kit
Red team footballers	red football kit
Santa	Santa Claus outfit – red, white-trimmed robes, belt, black boots, white beard, red hat
Mum and Dad	in dressing gowns, pyjamas and slippers(as if just got up on Christmas morning)
6 children	in dressing gowns, pyjamas and slippers (as if just got up on Christmas morning)
Angel and the angels Angel Gabriel	Traditional angel costumes – white/gold/silver/sparkly fabric, wings, halos, tinsel
Innkeeper	Traditional townspeople outfits
Shepherds and Joseph	Traditional biblical/nativity costumes e.g. long robes, cloaks, shawls, headdress with tea towels, sandals etc. Shepherds may have crooks / cuddly sheep
Mary	Mary to dress in blue robes.
Three Kings King 1 (to include a gift of gold) King 2 (to include a gift of frankincense) King 3 (to include a gift of myrrh)	Traditional nativity costumes e.g. long, luxurious robes/cloaks, jewels, crowns, sandals.
Roman soldier	Roman soldier outfit -helmet, armour, tunic, skirt, sandals, shield, sword
All other children	Boys – Christmas jumper or smart party outfit e.g. smart trousers, shirt, tie / bow tie, waistcoat
