Dear Parents and Carers,

As we move further into the spring and summer terms, we are beginning preparations to support our Year 6 pupils with their transition to Bryntirion Comprehensive School. This is an exciting time for the children as they start to become familiar with their new school.

The Headteacher at Bryntirion Comprehensive has already shared a letter outlining the key transition opportunities. For your convenience, the important dates are summarised below:

Friday 20th March – Year 6 pupils will visit Bryntirion Comprehensive School to watch a show. Pupils will be accompanied and transported by staff from Llangewydd Junior School.

Wednesday 25th March – 4:00pm – A parent meeting will take place at Bryntirion Comprehensive School to provide information about the transition process and life at the school.

Friday 1st May – Year 6 pupils will attend a Mini Olympics event at Bryntirion Comprehensive School. Pupils will be taken and supervised by Llangewydd staff.

Friday 26th June and Monday 29th June – Cluster Step-Up Days at Bryntirion Comprehensive School. On these days, parents and carers will need to **drop off and collect their children directly from the comprehensive school**.

Monday 29th June – 4:00pm – A further parent meeting will be held at Bryntirion Comprehensive School.

These activities are designed to help pupils feel confident and excited about their move to secondary school by giving them opportunities to become familiar with the staff, environment and other pupils.
