Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach our residential trip, I would like to highlight some important information and remind you of the arrangements for drop-off and collection.

### Drop-off on Wednesday 8 July (including medication)

- Pupils can be dropped off as usual for breakfast club at 8:15am or at 8:50am for the start of the school day.
- The Lower School Hall will be open for you to take your child's suitcase. Staff will be available to meet you, collect any medication and obtain consent for the administration of Calpol if required.
- If your child requires any medication (including hay fever medication or medicines purchased from a pharmacy), it must be placed in a clear, labelled bag with your child's name clearly marked on it and handed directly to a member of staff at drop-off.
- The coach is expected to leave between 9:30am and 10:00am (a confirmed departure time will be shared closer to the date). Parents and carers are welcome to wait on Heol-y-Frenhines to wave the children off.

### Collection on Friday 10 July

After a busy and exciting three days, the children often return feeling very tired. We expect the coach to arrive back at school between 2:00pm and 2:30pm. We will provide updates via text message on the day.

Parents and carers are welcome to collect their child upon arrival and take them home. If this is not possible, your child will remain in school until the normal end of the school day.

**\*Your child's place on the residential trip to Parkwood Residential Centre is dependent on their continued positive behaviour in line with the school's Behaviour Policy, and their ability to meet the safety requirements outlined in risk assessments by both the school and the centre. If their behaviour poses a risk or breaches these expectations, they may no longer be able to attend, and unfortunately, any deposit paid will be non-refundable.**



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## Reminders

- No money is required.
- Mobile phones and electronic devices must not be brought on the trip. Any devices brought will be collected and stored by staff.
- Children may bring snacks for their rooms, provided they are nut-free.
- Please ensure all items listed on the kit list are packed.
- Bug spray should be packed in addition to the items on the kit list.
- Please ensure all clothing and belongings are clearly named.
- We recommend packing the bag with your child so they know what they have brought and where items can be found.
- There will be no phone calls home unless there is an emergency.
- Photos and videos from the trip will be shared via Seesaw.

We want this trip to be a memorable experience and for all children to have the very best time. However, I would like to remind parents and carers that if there are any serious behavioural concerns, or if a child is putting themselves or others at risk, we will contact parents immediately and arrangements may need to be made for the child to return home. I am sure this will not be necessary, and I am looking forward to a positive and enjoyable trip for everyone.
