Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to share some exciting news with you regarding our Additional Learning Needs (ALN) provision at Llangewydd Primary School.

As some of you may already be aware, from September we will be opening our third specialist ALN class, which will cater for pupils with ASD and other complex needs. This is a significant achievement for our school and one that we are extremely proud of. The Local Authority has recognised the success of our existing specialist classes and has acknowledged our capacity to extend this provision to support more children. The opening of a third class is a reflection of the dedication, expertise and commitment of our staff, as well as the positive outcomes achieved by our learners.

The children have been involved in the exciting process of choosing new names for the classes. The new class names will be:

1. Dosbarth Cwtch (CARE)
2. Dosbarth Snug (CARE)
3. Dosbarth Burrow (MLD)

Our Governing Body is currently overseeing the recruitment of a third specialist class teacher. I am pleased to confirm that Mrs Porter, our ALNCo, will continue to lead and oversee all of our specialist provision. In addition, Miss Jones, who currently works within our mainstream department, will be moving into one of the specialist classes. Miss Jones brings a wealth of experience and expertise that will greatly benefit our learners. Once the recruitment process has been completed and our new teacher has been appointed, I will provide a further update.
