Dear Parent/Carer,

Wednesday 8th July – Friday 10th July

With our exciting Year 6 residential to Dolygaer fast approaching, I would like to remind you of the arrangements for the trip to ensure everything runs as smoothly as possible.

Departure – Wednesday 8th July

Children should arrive at school at their normal time via Heol y Frenhines:

- **Breakfast Club:** 8:15am
- **School Day:** 8:50am

Please note: On the morning of departure, all children must be accompanied into school by an adult.

Upon arrival, please take your child directly to the **Lower School Hall**. Before leaving, you will need to:

- Hand any medication to a member of staff.
- Complete and sign a medication consent form.

It is essential that this form is signed as it gives staff permission to administer any medication your child may require during the visit, including prescribed medication and medicines such as Calpol.

Once you have signed the form and handed over any medication, we kindly ask that parents leave the school site. You are very welcome to wait by the **Heol y Frenhines entrance** to wave the children off as they depart. The coach is expected to leave school at approximately **9:30am**.

Returning to School – Friday 10th July

The coach is expected to arrive back at school between **2:00pm and 2:30pm**.

When the children arrive, they will come back into the school building before being collected. If you wish, your child may go home early once they have returned.
