Summer Treats

Beach Cupcakes

Ingredients

110g softened butter

110g caster sugar

2 eggs

1tsp vanilla extract

110g self-raising flour

Any 3 biscuit

For the butter icing

150g of unsalted butter

300g icing sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

3 tbsp of milk

Blue food colouring



Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Preheat your oven to 180°C (160°C fan/Gas 4). Line a 12-hole cupcake/muffin tin with paper cases
2. Using an electric whisk, beat the softened butter and sugar together in a large bowl until the mixture is pale and fluffy.
3. Whisk in the eggs one at a time, scraping down the sides of the bowl after each addition. Mix in the vanilla extract.
4. Add the self-raising flour and a pinch of salt. Gently whisk or fold the mixture until it is just combined.
5. Spoon the batter evenly into the paper cases, filling them about half of the way full. Bake for 15 minutes or until golden brown.
6. Leave the cupcakes to cool in the tin for 5 minutes, then move them to a wire rack and let them cool completely.

For the butter icing

1. Put the softened butter into a large bowl and whisk it until it is super soft and creamy.
2. Sift the icing sugar into the bowl and add the vanilla extract. Start whisking on a slow speed then increase the speed until smooth.
3. Beat in the milk 1 tablespoon at a time until the buttercream is fluffy and spreadable and add in your blue food colouring.
4. Put your biscuit in a plastic bag then crush them up.
5. Spread you icing on the cake sprinkle the crusher biscuits on there then your done.



Strawberry Lemonade

First get your cup, after you have your cup pour lemonade into the glass until its half-filled. Get some strawberries and press hard to get the juice out or you can get strawberry juice. Mix for 2 minutes. Now add ice and lemon juice but only 3 drops. Then add a lemon on the side of the cup. You've now made strawberry lemonade!
