Boys

- Plain shirt (white, cream, light blue, or checked)
- Grey, brown, navy, or black shorts/trousers
- Knitted jumper or cardigan
- Long socks or knee-high socks if available
- Dark shoes or school shoes
- Flat cap (optional)
- Braces/suspenders (optional)
- Plain coat if the weather is cold

Girls

- Simple dress with a small pattern or plain colour
- Skirt and blouse/shirt as an alternative
- Cardigan or knitted jumper
- Knee-high socks or ankle socks
- Dark shoes or school shoes
- Hair ribbons, plaits, or simple hairstyle
- Plain coat if the weather is cold

Please Avoid

- Modern logos and large brand names
- Football kits
- Hoodies if possible
- Bright neon colours
- Modern trainers where an alternative shoe is available
- Fancy dress costumes purchased specifically for the event

Suggested items:

Sandwiches

- Jam sandwich
- Cheese sandwich
- Egg sandwich
- Ham / Spam / Billy Bear sandwich

Fruit & Vegetables

- Apple
- Pear
- Banana
- Carrot sticks

Sweet Treats

- Plain biscuits
- **Homemade** cake or sponge slice
- Fruit loaf
- Raisins

Drinks

- Water bottle
- Diluted squash

Optional Extras

- Hard-boiled egg
- Piece of cheese
- Plain crackers

Please remember that all lunch items must follow the school's usual food and allergy guidelines.

Please Avoid

- Sweets, chocolates, crisps, and fizzy drinks in packed lunches
